

Recreation Commission Meeting

A special meeting of the Stowe Recreation Commission was held Tuesday, September 19, 2017 in the Arena Meeting Room starting at 5:00 P.M.

Call to Order at 5:12 pm

Walt moved and Lynn seconded the motion to **approve the agenda.**

Consent Items: August 2, 2017 Minutes Lynn moved and Adam seconded the motion to approve. Unanimous.

Mayo Fields Task Force Report: Leo Clark, a non-Rec Commission member of the task force, presented on the report submitted to the Rec Commission on September 6, 2017. Leo suggested the Rec Commission approve the task force report so the Selectboard could address it at their September 25th meeting. There was discussion on the selectboard process, all-community conversations, the property and its use commitments by the Town of Stowe and Stowe Land Trust.

Father Rick moved and Walt seconded: The Recreation Commission of the Town of Stowe recommends the Selectboard put a line item on the town's capital budget to be decided at the March 2018 town meeting that allocates sufficient funding to conduct a professional engineering study of Mayo Farm recreation fields D and E and fields J and K to assess their suitability to support athletic fields as well as their agricultural values.¹

Approved by a unanimous vote.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned at 5:55 P.M.
