She described new program offerings such as VT Senior Games, Intergenerational programs, French Lessons, Art & Science of Kombucha, Soccer and baseball camps on the turf, and more. Brett asked if programming will be decreased as result of the department going from 3 to 2 full time staff. Matt and Kelli indicated that the number of programs has not decreased, some programs have been discontinued that were not seeing enough participation and new programs have taken their place. Brett suggested doing a news release in addition to the brochure to let people know of all the department does and offers.

Matt explained that there has not been a market or demand for the times which are currently vacant. If anyone were to be successful it would mean selling vacant ice rather than displacing current customers. The majority of vacant ice times are M-F 8am-3pm and nights after 9pm. There is some vacancy in the summer but there has been very little interest or market beyond what is currently sold. Lynn said he will draft a description of the intended purpose for the \$20k request and email to the Rec Comm in preparation for Town Meeting.
